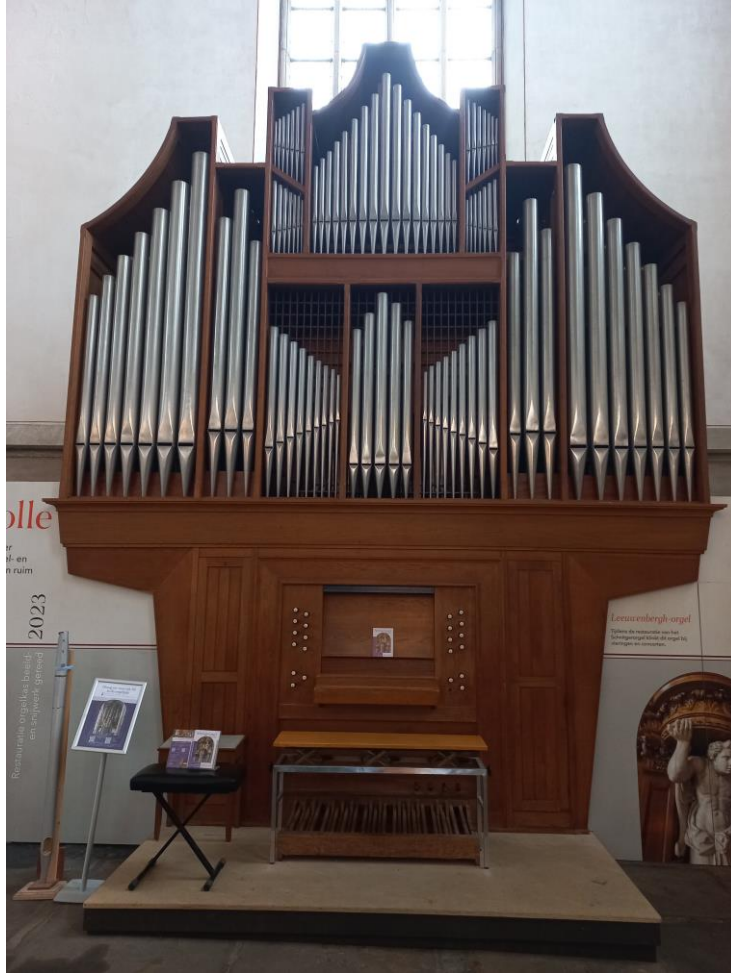


D.A. Flentrop organ (1954)
